

Directions to and Information about Camp Galilee

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From Reno and Carson City

Take US Highway 395 South through Carson City. South of Carson City turn RIGHT on US Highway 50 West to Lake Tahoe. Pass over Spooner Summit and continue on US 50 toward South Lake Tahoe. As the road approaches the edge of Lake Tahoe and you pass Glenbrook on the right, watch for the Fire Station and Post Office on the Left. Look for green sign saying Galilee with an arrow pointing the way.

From North Lake Tahoe

Take State Route 28 around the east shore of Lake Tahoe. At the intersection with US Highway 50 turn right toward South Lake Tahoe and follow the directions above into Glenbrook

From South Lake Tahoe

Take US highway 50 East toward Carson City. After passing through the tunnel at Cave Rock begin looking for the green sign saying Galilee with an arrow pointing the way.

Facility:

The absence of telephones and televisions in the rooms, cabins, and dorms makes Galilee the ideal retreat center. A telephone is available for emergencies. Smoking is not permitted on the property due to the many pine trees on the property and the high fire risk in the Tahoe basin. The meditation hall will be the newly renovated Hunting Lodge. It is a free standing house with a stone fireplace and breathtaking views of Lake Tahoe. Meals are served buffet style in Jenkins Dining Hall or on the picnic benches outside. There is also an outdoor amphitheater, on the lake's shore, which provides seating under the pine trees. Kayaks will be available for meditative rowing.

Accommodations

Galilee can provide summer camp style lodging and can accommodate up to 70 people; we will be using only about half of that capacity, so that the accommodations will be somewhat spacious. Single accommodation may be available and is dependent on retreat size. Most retreatants will have one to three roommates. Tent camping is permitted.
